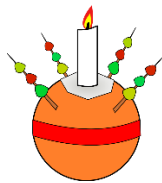


CHRISTMAS SERVICES 24 DECEMBER

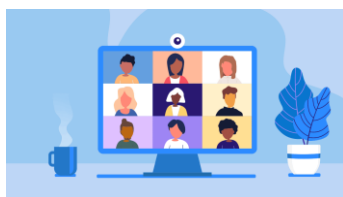
Gift Service and Christmas Fayre

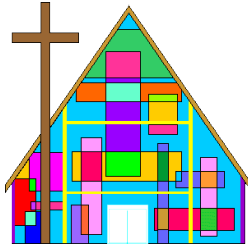


NEWTON WALLACETOWN
