We have placed green stickers on the pews to help with social distancing and ask that you keep 1m distance from each other (2m for choirs and when exercising). Please do not shake hands etc.



It is a government requirement that masks are worn in places of worship, please bring your own, if at all possible, as our supply is limited.



We have a seating system in place. **PLEASE FILL UP THE PEWS FROM FRONT TO BACK** when arriving and leave from back to front. **OFFERINGS** will be taken at the door (if applicable).



As we had to remove pew cushions, you may like to bring your own. This also applies to Pew Bibles, Orders of Service etc ( except for funerals and weddings), these will be displayed on the screen. You are welcome to bring your own (Orders of Service will be published on our website beforehand for you to print, if you wish)



Our maximum capacity is 72 including minister and organist, please do not be offended, if we have to close the door, when this capacity is reached. It is not what we want, it is the law. We will consider additional worship offers if demand exceeds capacity.
