Please help us to support the Scottish Government's Track and Trace System. The door duty will take your details (name and phone no, address is optional). Data protection information is available



We provide hand sanitiser for you, please do use it (you are welcome to use your own)



Please keep 2 m distance from others at all times, floor stickers and markings will help you with this. We ask for your patience if this means that you will have to wait a short time.



It is now a government requirement that masks are worn in places of worship, please bring your own, if at all possible, as our supply is limited.



We have a seating system in place, to ensure that the 2m distance rule can be ensured at all times. **PLEASE FILL UP THE PEWS FROM FRONT TO BACK** when arriving and leave from back to front. Signage with green ticks will let you know where you can sit, couples and members of the same household can sit together. Our friendly door duty will guide you. **OFFERINGS** will be taken at the door.



As we had to remove pew cushions, you may like to bring your own. Likewise, we cannot share Pew Bibles, Orders of Service etc, these will be displayed on the screen. You are welcome to bring your own (Orders of Service will be published on our website beforehand for you to print, if you wish)



Our maximum capacity is 37, please do not be offended, if we have to close the door, when this capacity is reached. It is not what we want, it is the law. We will consider additional worship offers if demand exceeds capacity.
